Gowin's aerial photographs of the cultivated landscapes in Spain's Andalusia region balance detail and breadth in sweeping vistas the colors of sand, soil, and cured meat. By keeping his pictures quite small, Gowin draws viewers into their intricately designed spaces, which can suggest the spirited abstractions of Joan Miró, with their patchwork fields and polka-dot plantings interrupted by ribboning rivers and deep fissures.
